VET CURRICULUM

One of the core topics was the collaborative review of the curriculum under development. The consortium is working on training programs for two new professional roles: accessibility consultancy and certification. These programs will combine technical and practical skills, adapted to national contexts but built on a shared European foundation.



COMMITMENT TO DIGITAL ACCESSIBILITY

AccessCoVE's work goes beyond content: it also focuses on accessible platforms and learning tools. In Stockholm, partners discussed audits, support materials, and improvement processes to ensure inclusive digital environments for all learners. Accessibility is also built through assistive technology.

NEXT STEPS:

AccessCoVE is moving steadily into the implementation phase. The next milestones include finalizing training materials, launching pilot programs for new professional profiles in accessibility, organizing the first Innovation Competition, and announcing the scientific conference and scientific journal of AccessCoVE.
